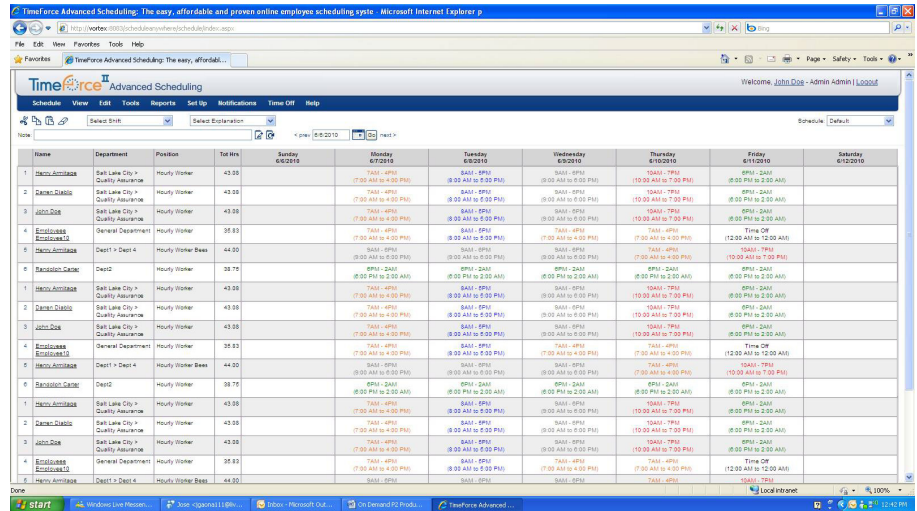

How It Works With TimeForce II

Data such as employees, departments, or tasks, are entered and maintained in TimeForce II and then sent to the Advanced Scheduling module. This transfer is done automatically as TimeForce users make changes. The user does not have to initiate any action to move data from TimeForce II to the Advanced Scheduling module.

Schedules and shifts are created in the Advanced Scheduling module and then "pulled" by TimeForce II. The schedules and shifts only transfer to TimeForce when the user is ready for the transfer to occur. Inside the TimeForce II application, the user simply presses the transfer button.

Compatibility

The Advanced Scheduling module is available with TimeForce II in a hosted (SaaS) environment only.
